





Meeting the COVID-19 challenge

In 2020, the pandemic affected our ability to continue our residential training centres, Gurukuls. The/Nudge team pivoted to design a completely online training program called Future Perfect focusing on the English language proficiency and 21st-century skills towards employability for youth in the service sector.

Building resilient livelihoods for extreme poor in Jharkhand

We continued working towards enabling the poor families in Jharkhand to come out of extreme poverty through the graduation approach (pioneered by BRAC in Bangladesh)¹. We empower women from these PVTG² households (referred to as didis) with:

- · consumption grants
- \cdot creation of a productive asset
- · diversified livelihoods
- · increase in income sustainably
- · increase in savings and access to credit









With lockdown, as they raised funds for the welfare of their differently abled staff, they realised they can use their culinary skills towards providing relief to the vulnerable communities in Bangalore, India.

The staff went on to serve 13 lakh low-cost, quality nutrition meals to homeless and daily wage workers, out of a mobile cafe during lockdown.

Sparking innovation at scale



The/Nudge Indian Administrative Fellowship




A program for senior professionals to stimulate large scale systems reforms by working on strategic initiatives led by visionary civil servants in government institutions




